Day One

🎵 Arrive in York County around noon and begin your visit with a little creative outdoor recreation. Several options are available: 1. Leadership training at Camp Canaan, outdoor venue along the Catawba River 2. Ropes course at The Outdoor Education Center 3. Nature walk at the Anne Springs Close Greenway

🎵 After students creatively express themselves outdoors, they will take a break and enjoy an “*Evening with the Catawba Indians*”, where they will experience a Native American meal, drumming, dancing, storytelling, and pottery demonstration.

Day Two

🎵 Following a breakfast at the hotel, students will perform 2 shows in the morning before arts-enthusiast audiences. After a break for lunch, the afternoon will be devoted to professional development workshops. Top arts leaders from the community will lead students in fun and educational workshops in their areas of interest. Arts leaders will include Winthrop University professors, professional actors, and arts educators.

🎵 In the evening, students will enjoy “southern” fun and entertainment. The history of southern music will be explored, while everyone enjoys a “pig pickin”, southern style.

🎵 Enjoy Carowinds while participating in the Annual Band, Orchestra and Jazz Festival or the Annual Choir & Show Choir Festival
