- Visit “The Sower” a fresco at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary
- JAARS, formally called the Jungle Aviation and Radio Service, is a must see. JAARS provides technical support and resources to help organizations speed Bible translation for all people - includes the Museum of the Alphabet and Mexico Cardenas Museum
- During the month of December, visitors can tour Samarian’s Purse and volunteer with Operation Christmas Child
- Enjoy an evening of arts at a Winthrop University Theater or Dance Production
- Experience traveling Broadway shows at Blumenthal Performing Arts Center
